About these release notes

These release notes are for administrators and summarize the changes in the updater and service packs for SMART GoWire™ auto-launch cables with SMART Meeting Pro™ software.

Product information

The SMART GoWire updater wizard for Windows® operating systems installs the latest version of SMART Meeting Pro software, SMART Ink™ and SMART Product Drivers on your SMART GoWire cable. The SMART GoWire cable enables you to use your interactive display quickly and easily, without installing software on your computer.

When you connect your SMART GoWire cable to a Windows computer, you can use all the features of the cable and of SMART Meeting Pro software. SMART Meeting Pro software enables you to write notes in digital ink, write on documents and applications, and access tools which help make your meetings more collaborative and engaging. Because SMART Meeting Pro software doesn't support Mac OS operating system software, you can use only SMART Ink and SMART Product Drivers when you connect your SMART GoWire cable to a Mac computer.



Updater for SMART GoWire cable with SMART Meeting Pro 3.1 SP1 software summary

About this release

This release enables you to choose Cisco® WebEx® integration when updating the software on SMART GoWire cables. With the latest software updates, administrators can automatically hide the Bridgit® meeting password on the Bridgit Collaboration Bar in SMART Meeting Pro software. This release also enhances support for using SMART GoWire cables with Mac computers and introduces changes that make the updater easier to use.

- SMART GoWire cable supports Mac OS X 10.8 operating system software.
- SMART Ink on the SMART GoWire cable supports PowerPoint® and handwriting recognition with Mac operating system software.

NOTES

- o SMART GoWire cables must be updated on Windows computers only.
- SMART Meeting Pro software supports Windows operating systems only. For further details, see the SMART Meeting Pro 3 software release notes (smarttech.com/kb/158840).
- SMART Ink and SMART Product Drivers on SMART GoWire cables supports
 Windows operating systems and Mac OS X operating system software. For further

Resolved issues

- You can update the SMART GoWire cable from behind a firewall or proxy server by typing in your network credentials when prompted.
- You can update multiple SMART GoWire cables in succession without downloading the .iso and .bin files again.

Known issues

If you're upgrading SMART Meeting Pro software from version 3.0 or 3.1 to version 3.1 SP1, you can retain your settings. However, if you're upgrading SMART Meeting Pro software from version 2.x or earlier to version 3.1 SP1, you're unable to retain your settings.

This release of the updater enables support for using the SMART GoWire cables with Windows and Mac computers. It also introduces changes that make the updater easier to use.

New features

- The updater downloads as a single executable file. When you run the executable file, it
 downloads the necessary files to update your SMART GoWire cables. Previously, the updater
 downloaded a bundle of files that included .iso and .bin files.
- After you update one SMART GoWire cable, the files that the updater downloads remain on your computer, so you can use them to update additional SMART GoWire cables. When you're done updating your SMART GoWire cables, you can delete the files from your computer.

 When you update the software on a SMART GoWire cable, you're prompted to install one of two groups of language packs for handwriting recognition:

I NOTE

The updater supports only English (U.S.), while SMART Meeting Pro 3.1 software supports the same 18 languages as version 3.0. See the *SMART Meeting Pro 3.1 system administrator's guide* (smarttech.com/kb/170323) for a list of these languages.

Known issues

Windows operating systems

- The updater doesn't support Windows 8 operating system.
- SMART GoWire cables don't support Microsoft® Lync® integration.
- You must be an administrator to install and use the updater.
- You can update only one SMART GoWire cable at a time.
- You must close SMART Meeting Pro software before you can start the updater.
- If you're upgrading SMART Meeting Pro software from version 3.0 to version 3.1, you can retain your settings. However, if you're upgrading SMART Meeting Pro software from version 2.x or earlier to version 3.1, you're unable to retain your settings.

Mac OS X operating system software

- When you connect your SMART GoWire cable to a computer, a window with an icon appears.
 When you double-click the icon, SMART Product Drivers, SMART Board® Tools, Floating
 Tools, SMART Ink and the SMART GoWire Launcher start.
- You need to accept the license whenever you connect a SMART GoWire cable to a computer
 for the first time. This is because the license acceptance information is saved on the computer
 rather than on the SMART GoWire cable.
