Quick start guide SMART Notebook[™] Publisher

SMART Notebook[™] Publisher is an Adobe® InDesign® plug-in that allows you to export InDesign files to SMART Notebook software. You can use InDesign to create compelling content, tag content for interactivity options, and then export it as a SMART Notebook file. You can then open the file in SMART Notebook software to add further interactive elements to your content or present your material on a SMART Board[™] interactive whiteboard. Beta release features

The beta release features a new document format optimized for SMART Notebook software, an option to export text and objects as vector or raster, the ability to modify their interactivity options, and an option to display or hide tags. Later versions of SMART Notebook Publisher will offer additional features.

Creating new documents for SMART Notebook software

You can create new documents for SMART Notebook software in InDesign. Your new documents match the size and landscape orientation of SMART Board interactive whiteboards, so the layout of your content doesn't change when you export to a SMART Notebook file.

Tagging text as vector or raster

You can export text from InDesign in either vector or raster format. Vector and raster text look the same after you export them to a SMART Notebook file, but you can edit only vector text. SMART Notebook Publisher's default setting is to export all InDesign content as raster, but you can tag text so that it exports as vector or raster.

Text that you tag as vector in InDesign exports to SMART Notebook software as vector text fields. SMART Notebook software recognizes these fields as text (not an object) so you can edit it and change attributes like font, color and size. You can export any font that's installed on your computer as vector.

One characteristic of vector text is that you can resize it without compromising quality.



Text that you tag as raster in InDesign exports to SMART Notebook software as pixel-based raster objects. You can see the pixels that make up raster objects when you zoom in. These text objects are recognised as images so you're unable to edit them after you export them.



Tagging objects as vector or raster

You can export objects such as lines and shapes as either vector or raster. You can edit objects you exported as vectors in SMART Notebook software.



You can export images only as raster.

Locking content

You can lock or protect text and objects you create in InDesign so that they can't be moved, rotated or edited after you export them into SMART Notebook software.

Linking content

You can link text and objects in InDesign to a web page or another page in the SMART Notebook file.

Cloning content

You can create multiple copies of content in the exported SMART Notebook file by enabling the Infinite Cloner. Simply drag and drop text or an object to duplicate it.

Using erase to reveal

You can enable Erase to Reveal which allows you to hide content with a color fill that you can erase in SMART Notebook software to reveal the hidden text or object.

Show or hide tags

You can show or hide tags in InDesign to help you identify rendering, locking and interactivity options assigned to text and objects when you export to a SMART Notebook file. For example, when you're showing tags, text that you tag as vector is identified with the vector icon \mathbf{V} .

This is tagged to export as vector text.

Installing SMART Notebook Publisher

Before installing SMART Notebook Publisher on your computer, ensure that SMART Notebook software is installed on your computer. You can download SMART Notebook software by going to <u>smarttech.com/software</u>. If you don't have a product key, you can request a developer license for SMART Notebook software through the <u>SMART Ecosystem Network</u>. Follow the installation instructions for either Mac or Windows® operating systems.

Computer requirements

SMART Notebook Publisher works with Adobe InDesign CS4 on both Mac and Windows operating systems. Adobe InDesign CS5 will be supported in future versions of SMART Notebook Publisher.

Installing on Mac operating system software

To install SMART Notebook Publisher

- 1. Visit the <u>SMART Notebook Publisher download page</u>, and then follow the on-screen instructions to download the file to your desktop.
- 2. Move the file to the following location: Applications/Adobe InDesign/CS4/Plug-Ins.

Installing on Windows operating systems

Tagging content for vector or raster export

You can export text and objects such as lines and shapes in vector or raster format. By default, all content is exported in raster format. You can tag text and objects as vector.

NOTES

То

- You're unable to export some formatting properties such as character spacing when you tag text for vector export. For more information, see the SMART Notebook Publisher Known Issues on the <u>SMART Notebook Publisher</u> download page.
- Exporting bulleted text as vector doesn't always work as expected.
- Lines or closed objects with bézier curves export as straight lines.
- Circles and ellipses aren't fully supported.

Tagging text for vector or raster export

You can export fonts that are installed on your computer as vector text. Here's a list of fonts common to most computers:

- Arial
 Arial Black
 Veranda
 Georgia
- Comic Sans MS
 Courier New
 Impact

You can export text as vector with the following formatting properties:

- Font size and color
 Bold, italics and underline
 Bullets
- Transparency
 Left and right alignment

To tag text or objects for vector export

- 1. Select the text or object.
- 2. Select SMART Notebook Publisher > Object Attributes.
- 3. Select Export as Vector under Rendering.

Locking content

When you create new content, it's unlocked by default. There are five options for locking content:

| Unlock | You can move, rotate and edit content |
|-----------------------|--|
| Lock in place | You can't move, rotate or edit content |
| Allow move | You can move, but can't rotate or edit content |
| Allow move and rotate | You can move or rotate, but can't edit content |
| Protect | You can't edit or unlock content after exporting it to SMART Notebook software |

NOTE

You can't copy and paste content if it's locked or protected.

To lock or protect content

- tent 1. Select the text or object.
 - 2. Select SMART Notebook Publisher > Object Attributes.
 - 3. Select an option under the Locking.

Adding hyperlinks

| To add a hyperlink | 1. Select the text or object. |

4. Select a color from the drop-down.

Showing or hiding tags

You can show or hide tags in InDesign to help you identify the properties assigned to text and objects when you export to a SMART Notebook file.

To show or hide tags 1. Select SMART Notebook Publisher > Show/Hide Tags.

2. Select Rendering, Locking or Interactivity.

NOTES

- If there's a check mark beside an option in the Show/Hide Tags menu, tags are showing for that option.
- Tags shown for Master Page content appear transparent.

Exporting to SMART Notebook files

To export to a SMART Notebook file

1. Select SMART Notebook Publisher > Export.

The Save As dialog box appears.

2. Type a name in the *File Name* area, and then click **Save**.
